



How Rieke Interiors created a one-of-a-kind vintage gathering space called "Hangar One" for this Aviation company.






The Problem

Our challenge was to take this unfinished storage space with concrete floors, walls & ceiling and create a warm, fun, and inviting atmosphere. The client wanted the space to have a vintage style to it to go along with the history of their company.

The Solution

We added drywall, a mix of flooring materials and acoustic baffles to help absorb the sound. We have a ping pong table that can also be used for meetings due to its writeable surface. We have lounge seating areas centered around TV's. There is a snack station, a full kitchen with island, sitting areas to eat, sitting areas to do work, and 3 private spaces for meetings, quiet time, or pilot resting. We incorporated a mix of purples, navy, and golds to coordinate with and bring in their logo branding. We also added touches of black and brass throughout and in their lighting selections to help add to the vintage vibe.










The Inspiration
